Kazimir Malevich's painting, *Black Square* (1915) had a decisive influence on the course of artistic developments in the 20th century. This artwork is iconic in the realm of abstract/non-objective art.

On the 100-year anniversary of the work, Irina Vakar has reassessed the evidence base around the painting and caused much excitement among art historians in the process.

With art historical findings from X-ray imagery and pigment samples, a new story of its creation and interpretation has emerged.

After the publication of the results in Russian and German, this long-awaited English edition is now available.

Malevich's abstract painting is not the sole focus — this book covers his complete oeuvre. For example, his theatre experiments, in particular the futuristic opera, *Victory Over the Sun* (premiere 1913), are linked to considerations on *Black Square*.
