The Public Art of Tess Jaray

Considering the dynamics of form, pattern and colour, Tess Jaray's public art transforms its architectural surroundings with sequences of interlocking geometric shapes.

For over three decades, Jaray's abstract painting has been complimented by a series of art projects that extends her investigation of space and perspective to the public sphere. Working primarily with materials such as brick, stone and metal, the forms of Jaray's public spaces are often held in an equilibrium of movement and stillness.

Drawing together 10 of the artist's important public commissions, this volume includes an essay by Charles Darwent that situates Jaray's projects within the tradition of twentieth-century public art, an interview with the artist by Doro Globus, as well as historic statements by Richard Cork and Glyn Emrys, among others.
