This publication is the result of a year-long dialogue between renowned **Sterling Prize winning architect, David Chipperfield** and architect, **Simon Kretz** (ETH Zurich).

Its aim is to **positively affect the future of urban developments**, providing a **manifesto** for a relational, collective and diverse future for our cities.

Using the **Bishopsgate goods yard site in East London as a case study**, this project highlights the conditions under which an ideal urban development project could flourish.

The conclusions reached through this exercise demonstrate **how future large-scale developments elsewhere could have more positive urban impact**, both at the scale of the neighbourhood and the wider metropolis.
