It has been published on the occasion of the artist's exhibition of new paintings and a new body of sculpture, *Der Kuss* at Blain|Southern, London (24 January - 17 March 2018).

The works in *Der Kuss* ask us to consider how memory can fix on banal imagery as a reference point for dramatic or traumatic occurrences such as war.

Includes a poem by Kate Dent and texts by psycho analyst Darian Leader, and Blain|Southern's Head of Exhibitions, Craig Burnett.
