Collective Works features work made by multi-disciplinary art collective UHC (Ultimate Holding Company) over the autumn, winter and spring of 2005 / 06. UHC was founded in 2002 in Manchester where it runs a number of experimental projects exploring collective art practice and political action. The collaboratively-developed pieces in *Collective Works* focus on power and regeneration in Manchester; the three sections of the book comprise *Interventions*, a selection of collectively-devised and executed street art actions; *The Thin Veneer of Democracy*, a 16-foot long boardroom table mapping the web of power relations controlling the city; and *OpenCity*, an illustrated essay introducing UHC's latest artist-led online research project (www.opencity.org.uk).
