From the French 'causer', to talk informally, Causeries details a series of encounters between British artist Alexandre Singh and various writers, scientists and philosophers on such wide-ranging topics as Hindu cosmogony, South Park, and scatology.

Causeries presents a selection of 29 public conversations conducted by Singh during his residency at Witte de With, Rotterdam in preparation for his play, The Humans.
