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## Key Selling Points

- Juergen Teller (b. 1964, Erlangen, Germany) studied at the Bayerische Staatslehranstalt für Photographie in Munich, before moving to London in 1986. Navigating both the art world and commercial photography, he has shot campaigns for brands such as Celine and Louis Vuitton, and editorials for a variety of magazines, including Arena Homme Plus and Pop
- In 2003, Teller was awarded the Citibank Prize for Photography, and, in 2018 he was awarded the Special Presentation ICP Infinity award. Major solo exhibitions of his work have been held at Garage Museum of Contemporary Art, Moscow (2018); Kunsthalle Bonn, Germany (2016) and DESTE Foundation, Athens (2014) among many others.
- Teller's work has been acquired by numerous international collections, including the Fondation Cartier pour l'art Contemporain, Paris; International Center for Photography, New York and National Portrait Gallery, London.
