Yoshitaka Amano is a diverse, prolific artist and thoroughly modern superluminary in the revered worlds of Japanese manga, anime and video games. He has recently turned to sumi-e, a 700 year old practice of monochrome ink painting that, until now, has had a rigid set of leitmotifs. No so in Amano's hands.

'In a similar manner as how his use of ink on rice paper resonates historically with centuries of Japanese drawing tradition, there is in Yoshitaka Amano's deftly casualized drawing style a mediation of calligraphy.'
