





Walter Pfeiffer 1970–1980

This title is a reprint of the original 1980 publication by the Swiss artist and photographer. With only full-bleed black and white images organized in visual sequences this publication suddenly brought Pfeiffer's Polaroids to the public's attention and became a sort of underground icon, flirting with gay subculture and what later became a mainstream style of magazine photography.

'In his earliest work Pfeiffer can be seen in relation to Larry Clark, as a photographer who not only captures but implicates himself in the restless '70s, and yet Pfeiffer's irreverent sense of humor sets him apart [...] Walter Pfeiffer's work both anticipated and paralleled that of the '80s photographers and, in so doing, looked ahead to much of what followed.
