This book brings together recent work by the British photographer Toby Glanville, made in the south east of England.

Like the best photographs, Glanville's restrained and delicate colour images – combining portraits with reflections on places – are both simple and densely weighted with the complexities of time and space.

His setting for the work is largely rural, and yet here he generates a response to people and their traces that is entirely contemporary and compelling.

Published to coincide with an exhibition of his work at the Victoria and Albert Museum in London, this timely publication establishes Glanville as an important voice in contemporary British photography.
